

Can I share a link to searches I have built with filters?

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Yes, you can! Share searches that you have curated on Selector with colleagues, collaborators, and more.

After applying filters to your search to narrow down your *product* and *figure results*, you may want to share your search with colleagues or collaborators. Click the **Save/Share** button to copy a link, or simply copy the URL from your browser's address bar.
